

DUNNAGE RETURN GUIDELINES

When returning dunnage to Craft Canning+ Printing, it's the **customer's responsibility** to ensure it gets returned in a timely manner. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the inability to credit your account.

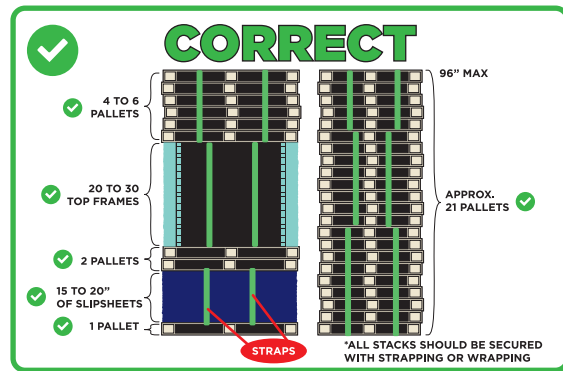
- All packaging materials should be stored inside and protected from the weather. Please store in a dry place. All materials should be sent back clean and ready to use. Materials should be protected from contact with contaminants such as grains, hops, paint, markers, lubricants, adhesives, staples, and chemicals.
- Please sort all dunnage by type and by manufacturer
 - Sort into separate categories for pallets, slip sheets, and top frames
 - All Crown dunnage should be sorted separate from Ball etc.
- All packaging should be assembled in straight uniform stacks. Dry and free of contamination.
- To prevent shifting or tipping during transit, all mixed stacks of materials should be arranged with bulk stacked slip/tier/typer sheets on the bottom, Top frames in the middle and plastic pallets on top. Please see attached images for proper banding and securing methods. This improves packaging return quality.
- Stacks should be no more than 96" high with 4 bands. Two bands going lengthwise and two widthwise across the stacks. I banding straps are not available, heavy plastic wrap is acceptable.
